Windows to the Soul: Portraits Unveiled

Windows to the Soul is an exhibit that focuses on the subjects of portraits – a drawing, painting, photograph, sculpture or any other representation of a person, in which the **human face** is the main theme. Must be 18-years of age and older. No images or work copied from copywritten material.

Specifications: Minimum painting size, excluding mat: 108 square inches (e.g., 9 x 12, 8 x 14, etc.). The maximum size not to exceed 48” x 48”.

Fee: The non-refundable fee is \$25 for CMAAA members, \$35 for non-members. Each fee allows you to submit up to two (2) entries.

Sales: Exhibited works will be considered for sale at the price indicated during the submission process to include the CMAAA commission of 25% for any artwork sold. Works not for sale must be designated “NFS”. Local sales taxes are added to all in-state sales, and they are the responsibility of the buyer.

People’s Choice Award: Visitors to CMAAA will be allowed to vote for their favorite art piece with the winner announced at the close of the exhibit.

Framing: Frame must be wired for hanging. No other types of hangers are allowed. All other work must be ready to install. CMAAA reserves the right to install accepted works in a manner deemed necessary for exhibit or security reasons.

Submissions: Images of work may be submitted by email, regular mail, or in person.

Acceptance and Exhibiting: Artists accepted will receive information pertinent to drop off, pick up dates, opening dates, etc. Only **accepted** work is allowed for exhibition. No substitutions. All work is to remain on exhibit for the duration of the show.

Publicity: CMAAA reserves the right to photograph all exhibited work for publicity purposes.

Delivery & Return: Accepted work may be shipped or hand delivered to CMAAA. Hours: Wednesday - Saturday, 10:00am - 5:00pm. Artists are responsible for insuring their work in transit to and from the Coliseum Museum. CMAAA provides minimal insurance for work while on premises.
